Instructions to take classes at the Strasbourg English Department:

Steps to undertake

1. Take a look at the courses offered.
2. Decide which of the available classes at the English Department you would like to take part in. **Take note of the semester dates under <https://www.unistra.fr/formation/admission-inscription-et-scolarite/calendrier-universitaire>**
3. Speak to your home university's academic coordinator for your study program/Eucor representative at your home English Department before enrolling in any classes at Strasbourg's English Department to find out whether the class you have chosen can be recognized by your home university as part of your degree program. 5. To enroll in courses and at the University of Strasbourg, contact the International Relations Office at lge-student-mobility@unistra.fr. They will help you fill in the learning agreement and the rest of the paperwork (a copy of your ID will be required). They will also provide you with the link for the online system. To register, you will need:
 - Learning Agreement (it will be drafted in the course of registration)
 - ID photos
 - A copy of your passport or identity card
 - (European Health Insurance Card, if you are from Europe)

6. Before your first class:
