<b>General description of the training offer</b>	About 90 courses per year providing transdisciplinary further qualifications for doctoral candidates. The courses teach core competencies and transferable skills in the following six areas: (1) Management, Communication and Leadership, (2) Publishing, Media and IT, (3) Career Planning and Career Entry, (4) Higher Education and Teaching Qualification, (5) Academic Practice and (6) Languages.
<b>Available languages</b>	German, English
<b>Conditions for participation of Eucor-postgraduates</b>	Generally open, but <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- due to registration via management system (HISInOne) online registration is only open for registered or matriculated doctoral candidates at the University of Freiburg and</li> <li>- because of the high demand almost all courses are booked out quickly.</li> </ul>
<b>Admission procedure (step-by-step)</b>	In principle, the courses are open to registered or matriculated doctoral candidates at the University of Freiburg who have an account. They may be attended free of charge. They register for workshops and courses online with their user identification and password. For Eucor - The European Campus doctoral candidates registration has to work different, meaning by hand: The doctoral candidate has to write an e-mail to Tina Lampe stating/proving that s/he is a Eucor-doctoral candidate and naming the courses s/he is interested in. Tina Lampe will then by hand confer the course asked for if there are free spaces.
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
