General description of the training offer	GRACE offers in between 50 and 60 Transferable Skills courses for PhD students and postdocs each semester. The courses are divided into five main categories: (1) Scientific Tools, (2) Writing and Publishing, (3) Communication, (4) Professional Self-Competence and (5) Career and Innovation. Additionally, there are courses that specifically address PhD students of the individual faculties.

Conditions for participation of Eucor-postgraduates	The Transferable Skills courses are principally open for PhD students of other Eucor Universities. But due to very high demand for the courses, it is often tough even for PhD students and postdocs of the University of Basel to get a place in the courses.
Admission procedure (step-by-step)	The Transferrable Skills course offerings are sent out twice a year at the beginning of the new semester. All courses are opened for online registration around the same time.
